Mount Allison University offers one of the strongest and most competitive scholarship and bursary programs in Canada with more than \$2,000,000 in scholarships, bursaries, and financial aid awarded each year. Required documents

If you are applying as a high school student, a complete undergraduate application for admission consists of the following:

- Submitted application for undergraduate admission.
- Official transcript sent directly from your high school to the Registrar's Office at Mount Allison. Grade 11 transcript including list of grade 12 courses is required for early admission. Mid-year grade 12 transcript is required by **March 1** for entrance scholarship consideration. Final transcript is required as soon as it becomes available.
- Proof of English language proficiency if applicable.

If you are applying as a transfer or mature student, a complete undergraduate application for admission consists of the following:

- Submitted application for undergraduate admission.
- Official high school transcript sent directly from your high school to the Registrar's Office at Mount Allison.
- Official post-secondary transcript(s) sent directly from your institution(s) to the Registrar's Office at Mount Allison.
- Resume
- Letter of intent
