Note: The following recommendations are taken mostly verbatim from the external review. For context they should be read in conjunction with the department's formal response.

Recommendations of the Academic Program Review

- 1. That, following the stop-gap one-year appointment already approved for 2022-23, the department be permitted to advertise for a tenure-track position to replace Dr. Wills.
- 2. That the department resubmit its request for a full-time tenure-track position in the Literatures of Canadian Diversity.
- 3. That the administration support a tenure-stream replacement position for Dr. Lapp at his retirement in 2023.
- 4. That the administration support the department's continued work in the ARTS program and commit to encouraging investment in the program more widely in the Faculty of Arts and Humanities.
- 5. That the department review and make explicit courses in other departments available for cross-listing, to allow for greater interdisciplinarity and hybrid knowledges.
- 6. That the department develop the new certificate in e-publishing to pursue creative experiential learning opportunities for students.
