**Note:** The following recommendations are taken mostly verbatim from the external review. For context they should be read in conjunction with the department's formal response.

**Recommendations of the Academic Program Review**

1. That, following the stop-gap one-year appointment already approved for 2022-23, the department be permitted to advertise for a tenure-track position to replace Dr. Wills.
2. That the department resubmit its request for a full-time tenure-track position in the Literatures of Canadian Diversity.
3. That the administration support a tenure-stream replacement position for Dr. Lapp at his retirement in 2023.
4. That the administration support the department's continued work in the ARTS program and commit to encouraging investment in the program more widely in the Faculty of Arts and Humanities.
5. That the department review and make explicit courses in other departments available for cross-listing, to allow for greater interdisciplinarity and hybrid knowledges.
6. That the department develop the new certificate in e-publishing to pursue creative experiential learning opportunities for students.
