Note: The following recommendations are taken mostly verbatim from the external review. For context they should be read in conjunction with the department's formal response.

Recommendations of the Academic Program Review

- 1. Change the department name to something like "Religion, Culture, and Community."
- 2. Implement the CENL Major and Honours programs.
- 3. Develop and apply to establish MEd and post-baccalaureate certificate programs.
- 4. Resolve the \$60,000 financial dispute with absolute transparency and clarity.
- 5. Establish a post-doc position in Islam with external and/or Ebbutts Trust funding.
- 6. Create and hire for a full-time, tenure-track position in Global Indigenous Spirituality to be shared between the RSD and CENL.
- 7. Create an administrative position modeled after the Lab Assistant/Technician role at Mount Allison.
- 8. Increase promotion of RS and CENL, possibly including a student position of 10 hours/week to handle social media.
- 9. Work with students to establish student societies.

- 10. If possible and desired, create office space for Dr. Shumka on the same floor as other RS faculty.
- 11. Explore possibilities for sharing practica supervision in CENL with other faculty in the unit.
- 12. The University needs to increase the number of course releases associated with service and successful grant applications to encourage research.
- 13. Create and hire two full-time, tenure-track positions to be shared between CENL and two other units.
