Submit this application form on or before June 1st to the Office of Dean of Graduate Studies using the same secure upload link that you used for your Graduate Studies application package. 
Greenidge Graduate Fellowships: Established by Dr. Dorothy Greenidge (Mount Allison class of '78), two awards are available annually to students entering a full-time thesis-based MSc program in Biology or in Chemistry (as indicated upon the Graduate Studies Application Form). If all candidates are equally qualified, preference is to be given to a female identifying student.

Value¹: \$10,000CAD; granted for a period of one year (non-renewable)

Robert L. Rice Memorial Graduate Fellowships: Established by the family of Robert Lewis Rice (Mount Allison classes of '48 and '50), two awards are available annually to students entering a full-time thesis-based MSc program in any field of Chemistry (as indicated upon the Graduate Studies Application Form).
Value¹: \$7,000CAD; granted for a period of one year, possibility of one renewal (renewal request: 1-page progress report due on or before June 1st of the student's second year)

¹ The award will be administered thus: half to support the guaranteed supervisor's stipend (as indicated on your Letter of Admission) and half in addition to the stipend.

Condition of award: One cannot hold a Canada Graduate Scholarship – Masters and one of these Mount Allison internal fellowships at the same time.
