Director's Note



If We Were Birds marks my second intimate encounter with the words of acclaimed Canadian Playwright Erin Shields, having previously directed her sumptuous and elegant play Montparnasse. Her style, her unflinching honesty, the poetry of her language, along with her choice of themes draws me in and has me imagining theatrical worlds simply by reading the evocative text on the pages of her plays. If We Were Birds has long been on my director's bucket list for its inclusion of many strong, vulnerable, and powerful female characters, its openness to interpretation, and for its authentic yet theatrical treatment of important issues. In the published version of the script, Shields includes a Note on The Chorus wherein she instructs the viewer that the members of our play's chorus "were inspired by testimonials of women survivors from the following conflicts: Nanking (1937), Berlin (1945), Bangladesh (1971), Bosnia-Herzegovina (1992-1995), and Rwanda (1994)" because of the ways sexualized violence against women was weaponized by the aggressors in such despicable ways during those wars.

I recently learned, in fact, how women continue to be victimized in the ongoing conflict in Ukraine, for example, using the very same weapon. Is this play, therefore, challenging to witness? Assuredly it is. But if the artist's job is to hold up a mirror to society, then the job of each of us is to open our eyes and see what is reflected back. Though at times this play is staged in abstract ways, the themes it depicts through its story are not abstract. They have happened, they are happening, and will happen again until we come to our senses as a species. It is my hope that the arcs of these great female characters which you will witness tonight brought to life by these brave and bold student actors will enlighten you, provoke you, and activate you.

Now is not the time to look away.


Ian McFarlane (He/They) Lighting Designer


Will Davis (He/They) Lighting Operator


