Recommendations of the Academic Program Review

- 1. The University should provide adequate research and teaching infrastructure to support the work of faculty and instructors.
- 2. Workload concerns should be addressed through increasing faculty, managing enrolment and optimizing instructor resources.
- 3. The admission criteria for the Honours program should be reviewed and modified to more accurately reflect the requirements for entry.
- 4. Support should be provided to facilitate the transition from teaching statistics with SPSS to R.
- 5. The Department and University should explore additional ways of recognizing and students' achievements.
