Port Elgin & Region Health Centre
May-Aug 2020**



The Loewen Internship was created by Mount Allison University's Chancellor, Lynn Loewen. This internship will support the placement of a Mount Allison student at the Port Elgin and Region Health Centre in Port Elgin NB in 2020.

The Port Elgin and Region Health Centre is a unique model of primary care that fosters learning and wellness for the whole community and provides the public with opportunities for health education, health promotion and access to health services.

In this role you would be a vital member of the team, working under the direction of the nurse practitioner to help support and deliver programs, community outreach and services to this small rural community, located 20 minutes outside of Sackville, NB.

The successful candidate will:

- Go into the local school and offer educational talks/programming (sun sense, etc)
- Create/run/manage community health programs (examples include weight loss and healthy eating/activities program one evening/week)
- Go out into the community for other clinics, such as blood pressure/sugar checks
- Other activities and support where required

The ideal candidate:

- Third year student with a keen interest in community health services, community outreach and the medical field
- Ability to take initiative and work independently
- Excellent communication and organizational skills
- Experience working with diverse clients would be an asset
